

About...



The Serenity in the Stadium idea was conceived by Read the Play General Manager, Michelle Gerdtz, who recognised the need for an event to celebrate World Mental Health Day in Geelong.

The idea was to promote the positive impact of physical activity on mental health, leading to the choice of yoga as the perfect activity.

The success of such an event relies heavily on strong collaborations. Kardinia Park Stadium Trust, which manages GMHBA Stadium, enthusiastically agreed to host this community initiative. Sally Ferris, the owner of Wonder Yoga in Geelong, joined as the instructor for the session. Additionally, Active Geelong partnered with Read the Play to bring this vision to life.

Serenity in the Stadium represents a meaningful collaboration between these local organisations, with all proceeds from the event dedicated to supporting Read the Play and Active Geelong's work in the Geelong community.

Read the Play is a mental health literacy program that supports young people aged 12-18 through local sporting clubs.

The program empowers young players to recognise mental health challenges, seek help, and support their peers.

With a purpose of building mentally strong sporting communities by prioritising youth mental wellness, RTP is expanding programs to include all sports in the Barwon region.

By working closely with clubs, volunteers, and parents, RTP ensures mental health remains a key focus in community sport.

Active Geelong seeks to make Geelong the most physically active region in Australia by 2030.

Despite widespread knowledge of the benefits of physical activity in preventing chronic diseases and improving mental health, 50% of Australians are not active enough, and 20% of Geelong's adult population are reporting NO physical activity at all.

Given these alarming statistics and knowing that 47% of employees work in sedentary jobs, Active Geelong has become the leading voice in the Geelong region calling on the population to participate in higher levels of physical activity to enjoy improved physical and mental health.

The Event...



Serenity in the Stadium is a one-hour yoga class on the halved turf of GMHBA Stadium, that blends tranquillity with community spirit.

Whether you're an experienced yogi, or just starting out, this event is about much more than just yoga. It's a chance to connect, support each other, and embrace movement and mindfulness in a supportive setting.

Be part of our inspiring journey toward better mental health. Together, we can make a difference and highlight the importance of mental wellness.

At the inaugural event last year, more than 250 people attended and overwhelmingly confirmed that they will be coming back next year, such was the quality of their experience.
